

NATIONAL INCIDENT MANAGEMENT SYSTEM (NIMS) AN INTRODUCTION – (ICS-700)

Course Description:

This course introduces and overviews the National Incident Management System (NIMS). NIMS provide a consistent nationwide template to enable all government, private-sector, and nongovernmental organizations to work together during domestic incidents. This course provides a basic introduction to NIMS. It is not designed to replace Incident Command System and position-specific training. This program is designed for individuals with emergency response responsibilities including prevention, preparedness, response, recovery and mitigation.

This course is one of a series that is required for NIMS Compliance.

There is an exam associated with this course. It is recommended that students go online to http://training.fema.gov/EMIWeb/IS/IS700a.asp to take the final exam. Taking the exam online will get the student certificate in a shorter timeframe.
