### 26. NFA Fire Service Safety Culture: Who Protects Firefighters from Firefighters?

Topics include safety and risk cultures within organizations; influences on safety culture and risk categories; concepts, goals, and processes of risk management. The course incorporates a facilitated student-centered methodologies including lecture, small and large group activities, and individual assessments.
