301 Arson I – Fire Investigations for First Responders

This is the National Fire Academy course, “Fire Investigations for Fire Responders” (2022). The purpose of this course is to provide first responders with the tools to understand the key role they play in fire scene examination and in preserving and protecting important evidence for any subsequent investigation. The content of the course will provide a clear definition of the role of the first responder and identify the preservation and protection of evidence and proper reporting of the information to appropriate officials. This course exceeds the requirements of FIR 1035 in the KCTCS Fire Science Technology program.

All class participants will need to obtain a FEMA Student Identification (SID) number and provide it on the first day of class.
