203 Incident Safety Officer (National Fire Academy)

This course examines the Safety Officer's role at emergency incidents. This course focuses on operations within an Incident Command System (ICS) as a Safety Officer and emphasizes response to all-hazards types of situations. Individuals attending this course should have a working knowledge of ICS as taught by the National Fire Academy, building construction principles, hazardous materials management, applicable National Fire Protection Association guidelines, and federal regulations.

Class size is limited to 30 students.
