OBJECTIVES:

The fire truck is used for training in the following venues:

- 1) Fire Science Degree program
- 2) driver training programs
- 3) pump operations
- 4) live fire training where a pumper is necessary

CAPABILITIES:

The 1981 Pierce pumper was retired from the Owensboro Fire Department and came to the Area 3 Training Center in 2006. This truck was refurbished in 1994. It has a Detroit diesel engine and an automatic transmission. The truck has a 1250 gpm pump. There is approximately 500 feet of 5" supply line, 300 feet of 3" supply line, 250' of 2 ½" attack line and 3 pre-connected 1 ¾" attack lines.
