Course Description:

Provides knowledge necessary to safely manage multi-casualty incidents and rescue situations, utilize air medical resources, identify hazardous materials, perform vehicle extrication, and minimize the associated risks related to terrorism and disaster.

2. Exercise sufficient judgment and accept responsibility for scene and patient management.

5. Understand the relevance of communications and documentation relative to EMS operations.
